Leading Edge Endoscopy

PillCam™ - video capsule endoscopy



The Given video capsule endoscopy system is a first-line tool in the detection of abnormalities of the small bowel. To date over 340,000 patients worldwide have experienced the advantages of painless and effective PillCam™ Capsule Endoscopy.

PillCam™ Capsule Endoscopy has already been utilised to diagnose diseases of the small intestine including Crohn's Disease, Celiac disease and other malabsorption disorders, benign and malignant tumours of the small intestine, vascular disorders and medication related small bowel injury.

Capsule endoscopy with PillCam™ SB video capsule enables our specialists to examine the entire small intestine. Patients ingest a vitamin-pill sized video capsule, which has its own camera and light source. While the video capsule travels through the body, it sends images to a data recorder worn on a waist belt. At the end of the procedure, the data recorder and sensor array are returned to the specialists. The images acquired will then be downloaded to a workstation for the specialist to review.

Capsule endoscopy helps to determine the cause for recurrent or persistent symptoms such as abdominal pain, diarrhoea, bleeding or anaemia. In certain chronic gastrointestinal diseases, this method can also help to evaluate the extent to which the small intestine is involved or monitor the effect of therapy.

The capsule is 11mm x 26mm and weighs less than 4 grams.

- The capsule field of view is 140 degrees.
- In a normal (eight hour) procedure the capsule generates approximately 57,000 images, at a rate of two frames per second.
- The capsule enables the detection of objects at a minimum size of less than 0.1 mm

This service is now available at Braemar Day Hospital through our specialist Gastroenterologists. Patients will be required to attend the hospital so that the sensors and data recorder can be fitted and the capsule swallowed. They will then be asked to return the data recorder the following day. The capsule is excreted naturally.
