New Hospital Site Purchased

A superb site for our new hospital has been purchased.

That site is "The Nest" property on the corner of Ohaupo Road and Kahikatea Drive previously owned by The Salvation Army.

The first stage of the development will allow us to relocate our Tainui Street hospital plus build in some additional capacity. The second stage will see our day hospital in Knox Street relocated.

At over 1.6 hectares the site is much larger than required for our current needs and allows plenty of room for expansion in the future.

Return-to-Theatre Indemnity

Braemar Hospital is 100% owned by the Braemar Charitable Trust. As part of their charitable obligations the Trust has recently introduced a 'return-to-theatre indemnity' that meets the hospital costs for uninsured patients should an unexpected return-to-theatre be necessary.

Special Care Unit (ICU / HDU)

The unit meets the post-operative needs of patients requiring ventilation or close monitoring following major surgery.

Affordable Private Healthcare

Braemar Day Hospital was the first hospital in New Zealand to gain certification under the new Day-stay Surgery and Procedures Standard (NZS 8164:2005), for a full three year period.

Braemar Hospital has Certification under the Health and Disability Sector Standards (Safety) Act also for a full three year period.
